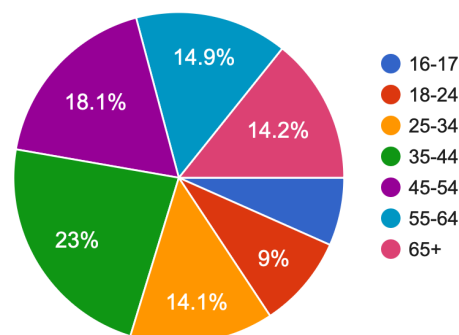

Age of Crossroads Attendees:

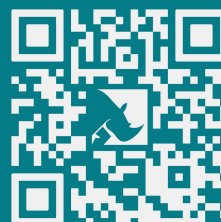

REMEMBERING THE WHY

The launch of The ONE Center is the primary focus of the Unstoppable initiative this year, and everyday we are reading stories reminding us why The ONE Center is so important. Whether it's mental health issues or navigating relationship issues, there is a tremendous need in the Valley for counseling.

According to the 2022 Community Health Needs Assessment by Kaiser Permanente, mental and behavioral health ranks among the top health priorities in the Manteca service area. Sadly, the region experiences a 25% higher rate of "deaths of despair"—including suicides, drug overdoses, and alcohol-related deaths—compared to the California average. But, there are 32% fewer mental health providers per 100,000 residents than the state average.

As a church we have set out to stand in the gap to help people who are hurting find healing and freedom in Christ through The ONE Center.

RECENT DEVELOPMENTS

- **City Planning Permission:** We are making progress with the City on planning permission for the building and are getting ready to move on to permitting.
- **Construction Budget:** We have received the budget from our General Contractor for the building and they are now working on competitive bids from subcontractors.
